EDUCATION	Task Force Report accepted; now needs to be updated, extended, completed with survey results All members: consider who might be interested in carrying out ECTP research on education and training: researchers in planning schools? Someone in your association?
RECOGNITION	Revised (EN + FR) definitions of planning <i>attached</i> All members: use ExCo summary of the issue (in preparation) when available to inform your members of progress in this important area
EXCHANGE WEBPAGE	RTPI and FAB work together to construct the links
